

Registering to play Hockey with Central in 2020

Welcome All to the 2020 Winter Hockey Season!

Please see the Central Hockey Club "Information Sheet" which provides key information about season start dates, training times, and fees. The all-important Registration Process (carried out via the HACT "Revolutionise" Online Registration System) is described below.

Your immediate "next step" is to confirm your availability to play with Central in the 2020 Winter Competition by **registering**, because the *senior season commences the weekend of 27/28/29 March*.

Training for all senior Grades commences ***Thursday 12 March for women and Tuesday 10 March for men (all grades) at the NHC Lyneham***. See the Central Information Sheet, available for download on the Central website, for further information on times and field allocations for training.

The junior season commences on the weekend of 1,2,3 May with junior training starting on Wednesday 18 March 5pm-6pm (Boys: Powell field; Girls: Watt field)

Online registration for 2020 will again be administered through "**Revolutionise**". Access to "Revolutionise" is done via the Registration tab on the Central website (follow the prompts). Central players that played hockey in Canberra since 2018 outdoor season should select the "renew" option; New players to Central, or previous Central players that did not play since will need to select the "register" option.

The Hockey Australia levy will also be charged at the time of registration. For 2020, The Senior Levy (players turning age 19 or over in the calendar year) is \$43.00 + RevSport fees (2% + \$1.60) and the Junior Levy (players turning age 10 – 18 in the calendar year) is \$31.50 + RevSport fees (2% + \$1.60).

Central's preferred payment method for Club Fees is via the Revolutionise System at the time of registration (note a Revolutionise transaction fee remains applicable). EFT to the Central Hockey Bank Account remains a payment option, as indicated on the 2019 Information Sheet.

Other things to consider before you start registering:

As before there are a number of questions that you need to answer to help us with managing teams and making sure you have an enjoyable playing experience.

When you register you need to select the grade and competition you wish to play in. Please remember that Central has a selection policy and a selection committee and you may be regraded depending on numbers and ability. If you are regraded to a lower grade any excess fees paid will be refunded and if you regraded to a higher grade you will be invoiced for the additional amount.

If you want to pay in full online:

If you intend paying your fees in full when you register, you must select the payment class (Registration Type) that matches what competition you want to play in. eg, U11's, Juniors only, Juniors playing Seniors or Seniors. Once you have selected the Registration Type you will be able to select the Add On that fits the grade type you wish to play. (if you are a Junior playing senior Hockey you only have to pick what senior grade you want to play) Then fill out all the questions asked and you

will then be able to pay the fees using a credit or debit card. If you use this method you will be charged the Levy and player fees plus administrative charges.

If you want to pay via EFT into Central's bank account:

If you wish to pay via EFT to Central's bank account, to apply for a payment plan, or family discount, or student discount 'you must select the payment class (Registration Type) that matches what competition you want to play in. eg, U11's, Juniors only, Juniors playing Seniors or Seniors. Then select Renew Membership without selecting the Add On's. Then fill out all the questions asked, and you will then be able to pay using a credit or debit card. If you use this method you will be charged the Levy plus administrative charges. You must pay/select this levy in order to take the field in any HACT competition and be covered by insurance.

If you pay by this method, an invoice will be raised and sent to you for the Central playing fee. This will be based on your preferred grade you are selected in, and whether you have requested a payment plan or family discount.

How non-players can register:

If you won't be playing, but will be supporting the club by being a coach or manager of a team, you will need to register with Revolutionise, so you can log in and create team lists. There is a category for you which doesn't require the payment of any fees, however you will need to agree to abide by HACT and Central policies. The system will say you will be invoiced for \$0. You can also use this category if you are a Central supporter who no longer plays but would like to be considered a member, and therefore able to vote at the Club's Annual General Meeting etc.

How to Register Yourself with Central Hockey Club

1. Go to the Club website - [Central Registration](#) and click on the "Register with Central Hockey Club" link
2. Then click on Registration
3. Press Register or Renew
4. Add your First Name, Last Name and Date of Birth
5. Select your Registration type from the drop-down menu (please read the above details to help you decide what type you should select, depending on how you wish to pay).
6. Click the Add On if you intend on paying up front when you register.
7. Then press Next Step
8. Enter your details in the fields specified.
9. Complete the payment details.
